
Innovative Ways I Use in My English Classroom

In my English classroom, I like to make learning fun and exciting. I use many interesting and creative ways to teach my students. These activities help them enjoy the lesson and understand it better.

One of my favourite methods is using different types of claps. We do "Firecracker Clap", "Whistle Clap", and "Round of Applause". These claps make the class cheerful and help students stay active. When someone gives a correct answer, the whole class claps together. This creates a happy and positive learning environment.

I also use sticky notes with kind and encouraging words. When a student does something good, I give them a sticky note. The notes say things like "Great Job!", "You are a star!", or "Keep it up!". Students love collecting them in their notebooks. It helps them feel proud and work harder.

Another fun activity we do is the jumping grammar game. I place word cards on the floor with different parts of speech. When I say "jump to a verb", students hop to the correct word. This helps them learn grammar in a fun and active way.

To keep the class lively, I often change the seating plan. Students sit in pairs, groups, or even in a circle. This helps them talk and learn from each other.

Learning English becomes more joyful with games and praise. Students feel more confident when they are appreciated. They are not afraid to speak, read, or write anymore. They know that mistakes are okay and part of learning.

My classroom is full of laughter, claps, and learning.
